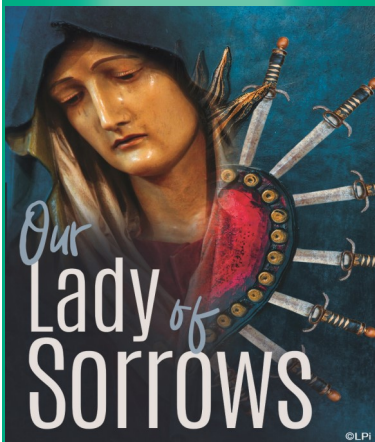

(Romans 14:8)

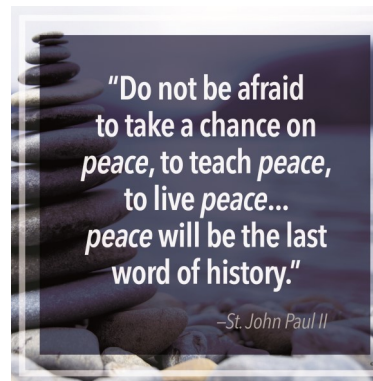
