2021 Initial Formation for Diocesan Certified Lay Leaders of Prayer Aug. 20-21, & Oct. 22-23

The two required formation sessions for those seeking initial diocesan certification as lay leaders of prayer are August 20-21 and October 22-23. The sessions will take place at St. Anthony of Padua Church, Park Falls. Both sessions begin Friday evening and conclude late Saturday afternoon. Each applicant must:

- 1. register and
- 2. must also be specifically selected and recommended by their pastor, parish director or parish life coordinator via the completed Application Form.




