

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

In todays parable of the sheep and goats, Jesus calls us to the work of living community - community that is centered in the holiness of God that dwells within every man, woman and child; community that sees deeper than the externals of race, nationality, culture and language in order to behold the love of God animating the lives of all who draw breath; community that images the compassion and mercy of God in its members' care of one another.

To belong to and build such a community is central to the baptismal call of the disciple to build the kingdom of God in our own time and place.

Now, as we approach the Season of Advent, our COVID-19 cases are on a very serious climb. With this letter I am authorizing you to celebrate the third form of the Rite of Penance beginning immediately and for the duration of this pandemic.

- the Rite I form of Penance, which is ordinarily accomplished through individual and integral confession to a priest followed by individual absolution, remains to be the ordinary or normal form for the celebration of the Sacrament of Penance;
- 2. the permission to celebrate the Rite III form of Penance is for the duration of the COVID-19 pandemic or until the Holy See withdraws the current exceptional permission;
- 3. the Rite III form of Penance (General Absolution) is to take place at a separate time from Mass or any other liturgical/spiritual gathering;
- 4. penitents need to be reminded that any mortal sins forgiven in a Rite III form of Penance need to be confessed at the next possible opportunity for the "ordinary" Rite I form of Penance after the COVID pandemic is over; (Bishop James Powers)

We will begin on December 5th at 1:00 p.m. and continue on December 12th and 19th.
