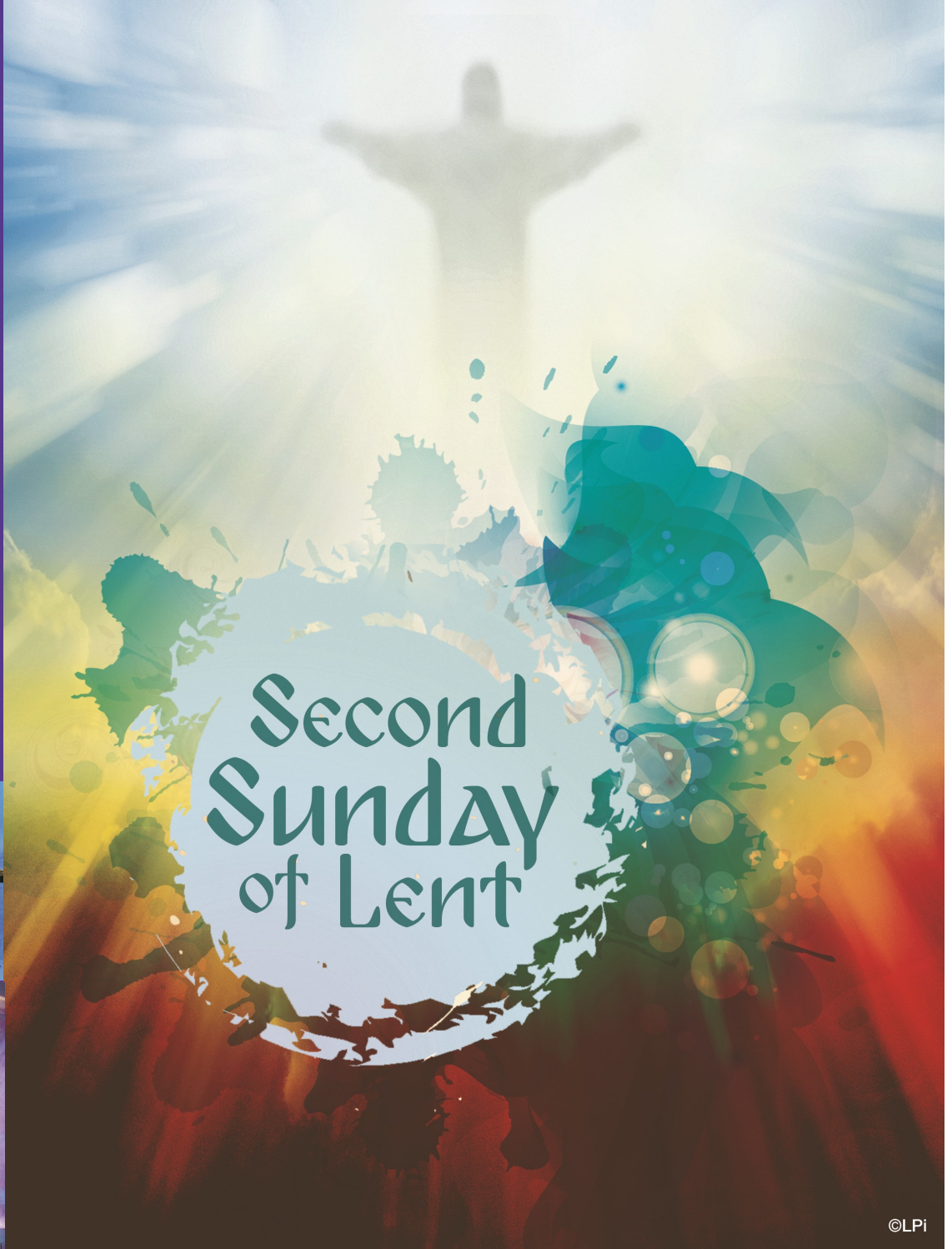

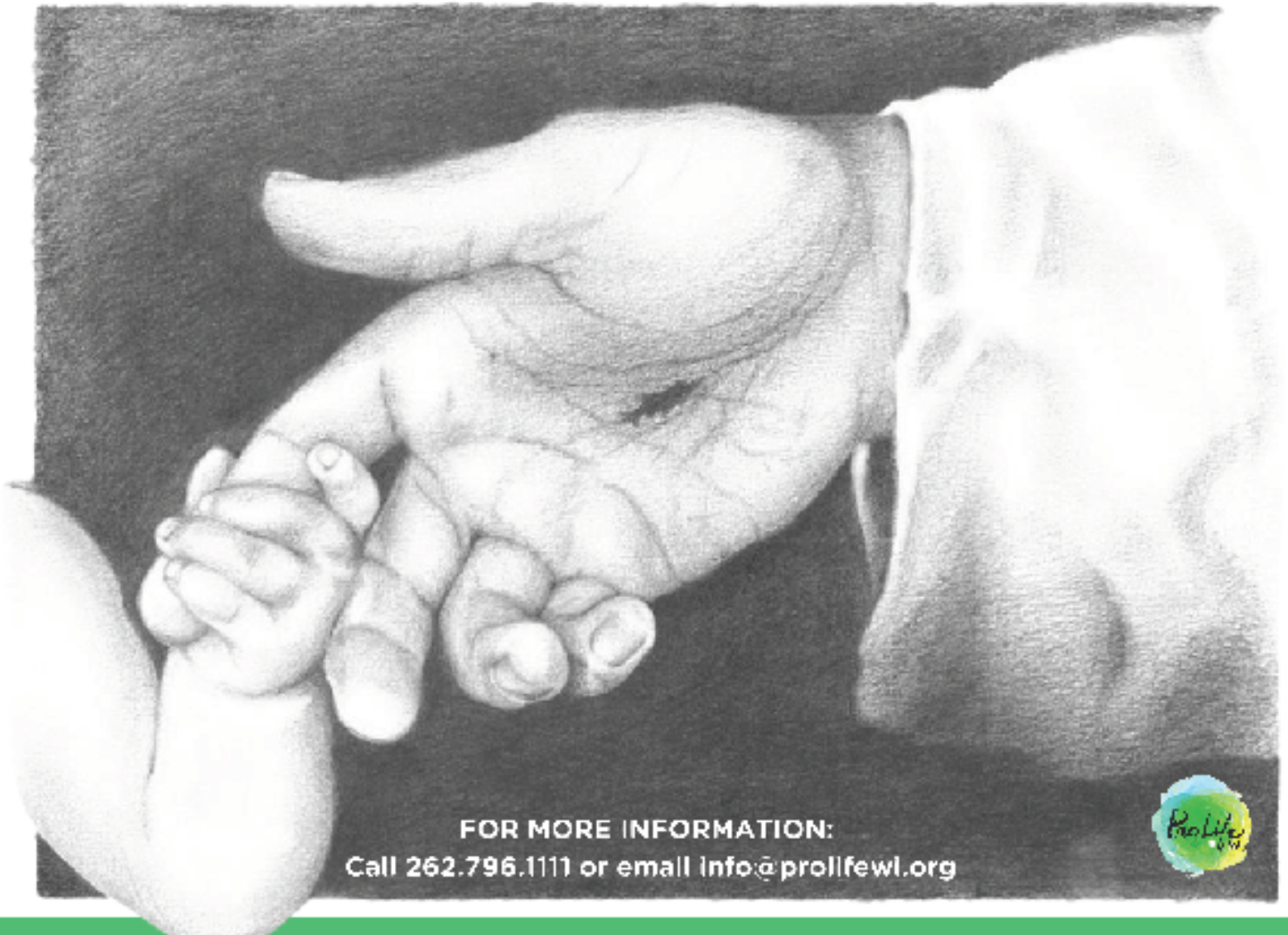

Criteria:

- \*A graduating female, active in the Catholic faith, pursuing a college degree at the school of her choice
- \*A high school grade point average of 2.5 or better
- \*Must be accepted and enrolled in a technical/community college or university
- \*Must have demonstrated characteristics of the Daughters motto: Unity, Friendship, and Charity

Selection:

\*The application for this scholarship will be reviewed by an appointed committee of the Daughters of Isabella. If deemed necessary, the school counselor will be consulted. The organization's body present at a monthly meeting will make the decision. The D of I reserve the right to reject any and all applications as they deem necessary. They also reserve the right to terminate the scholarship at any time in the future.

Payment:

- \*Value \$500
- \*Scholarship will be paid after successful completion of the first semester, provided the recipient maintained a G.P.A. of 2.0 and has officially enrolled in the second semester. Copy of the transcript is required.

- \*In the event that the recipient does not attend an institution of higher education with twelve (12) months of graduation, the D of I will withdraw the scholarship awarded and funds will be awarded to another recipient in subsequent years.
